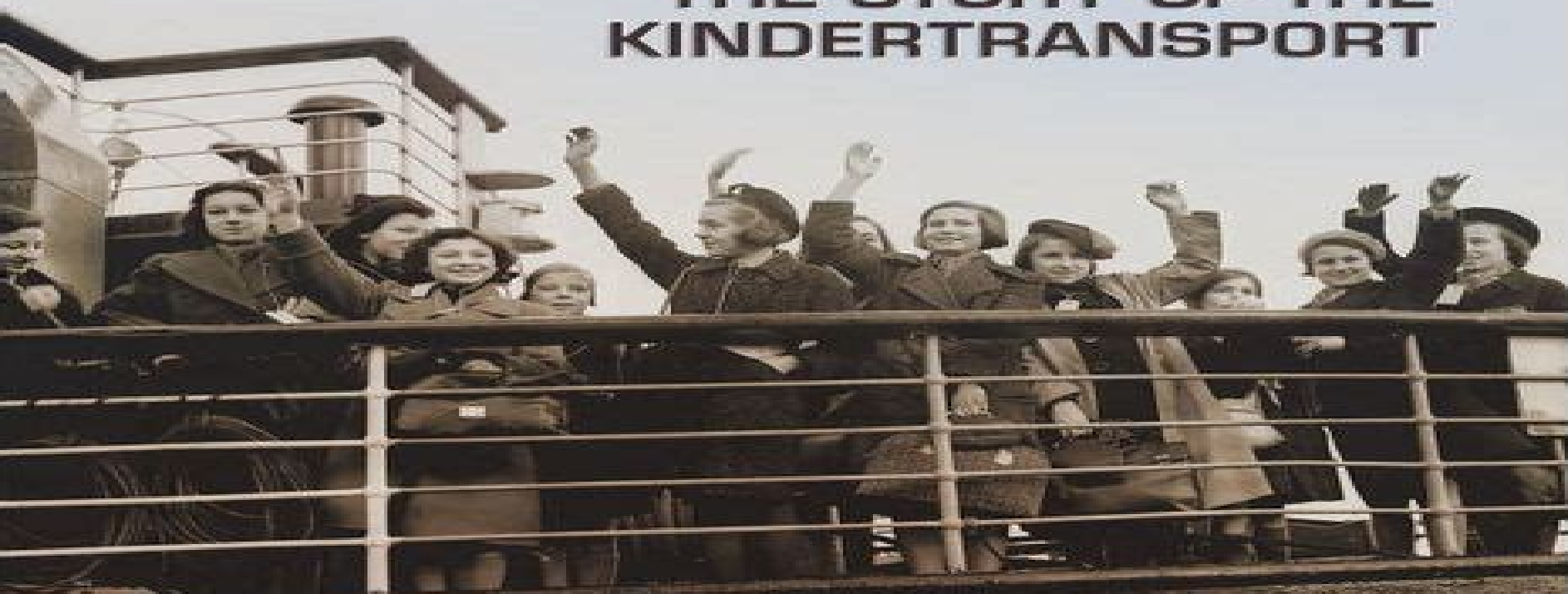

The Rescued Generation: When Humanity Prevailed Pasquale De Marco, 2025-07-24 *The Rescued Generation When Humanity Prevailed* is the story of the Kindertransport a rescue operation that saved 669 Jewish children from Nazi occupied Europe In December 1938 Nicholas Winton a British stockbroker was sent to Czechoslovakia to help refugees fleeing the Nazis He was shocked by the plight of the children he saw and determined to do something to help them Winton worked tirelessly to find homes for the children and to arrange for their transport to the UK He was assisted by a group of volunteers including social workers teachers and members of the British government The first Kindertransport train arrived in London on December 1 1938 In the months that followed eight trains brought a total of 669 children to the UK The children were placed in foster homes or hostels and they were given the opportunity to continue their education The Kindertransport was a remarkable achievement It saved the lives of thousands of children and gave them the chance to build new lives in a safe and welcoming country The children who were saved by the Kindertransport went on to make significant contributions to their adopted country They became doctors lawyers teachers and artists They raised families and helped to build a better world *The Rescued Generation* is a story of hope and courage in the face of unimaginable darkness It is a story of the power of human compassion and the importance of standing up for what is right It is a story that should be told and retold for generations to come *The Rescued Generation* is more than just a story of the past It is a story that has relevance for today In a world where children are still suffering from war and persecution the Kindertransport is a reminder of the importance of protecting children and giving them the chance to build a better future If you like this book write a review
