

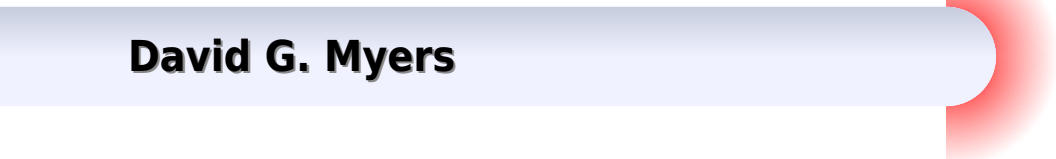
Chapter 1: Thinking Critically with Psychological Science

Wilhelm Wundt establish the first psychological laboratory in 1879 in Germany. Two early school in psychology were structuralism and functionalism. Structuralism promoted by Wundt and Titchener, used self-reflection to learn about minds and structure. Functionalism, promoted by James, explored how behavior and thinking function.
4. **Describe how psychology continued to develop from the 1920s through today.**
Early researchers defined psychology as a science of mental life. In the 1920s under the influence of John B. Watson and the behaviorists, the fields focus changed the scientific study of observable behavior
5. **Discuss how our understanding of biology and experience, culture and gender, and human flourishing has shaped contemporary psychology.**
Our growing's understanding of biology and experience has fed psychology's most enduring debate. The nature- nurture issue centers on the relative contributions of genes and experience and their interaction in specific environments. Cross- cultural and genre studies have diversified psychology's assumptions while also reminding us of our similarities.
6. **Summarize the nature-nurture debate in psychology.**
The longstanding controversy over the relative contributions that genes and experience make to the development of psychological traits and behaviors today's science sees traits and behaviors arising from the interaction of nature and nurture.
7. **Identify the three main levels of analysis in the biopsychosocial approach, and explain why psychology's varied perspectives are complementary.**
the biopsychosocial approach integrated information from the biological and social cultural levels of analysis. Psychologists study human behaviors and mental processes from many different perspectives evolutionary behavior genetics psychodynamic behavioral cognitive and social cultural. Research rebates a more complete understanding of behaviors and mental processes than would be available from any one viewpoint alone.
