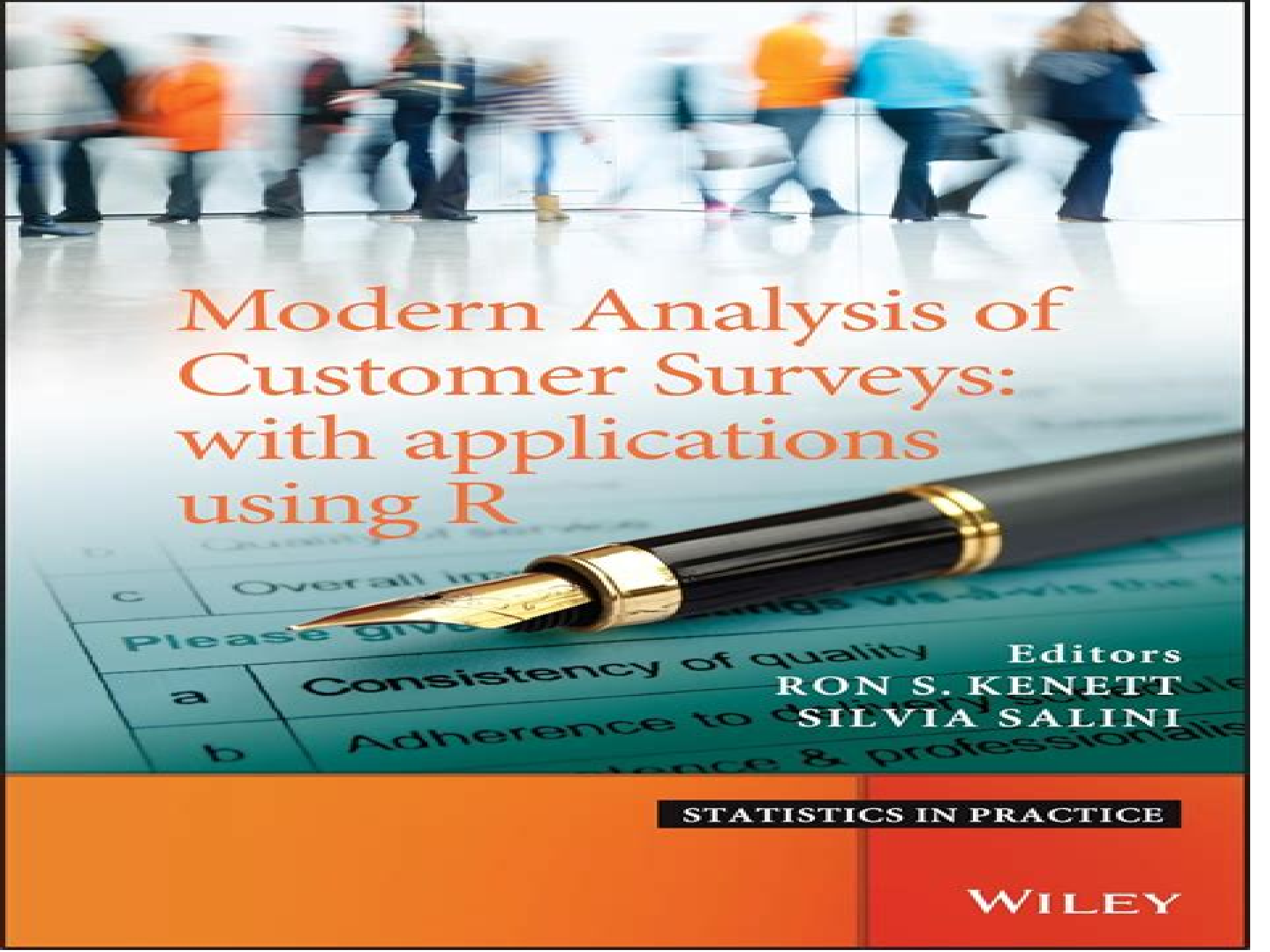

It covers topics such as statistical process control including multivariate methods, the design of experiments including computer experiments and reliability methods including Bayesian
