

OUR KIND OF PEOPLE: INSIDE AMERICA'S BLACK UPPER CLASS

Lawrence Otis Graham. New York, NY: HarperCollins, 1999. 418 pp.

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Upon publication and in the decades since, E. Franklin Frazier's *Black Bourgeoisie: The Rise of a New Middle Class in the United States* (1957) has drawn equal amounts of ire and respect. Frazier's analysis of the African American new middle class is raw in its contention that black Americans have relinquished the opportunity to create another path to prosperity which might be more inclusive. Instead, Frazier contends, they have chosen to rally barriers of status and prestige in closed social milieus and garrobed new dectial enclaves.

For members of groups previously stigmatized because of race, gender, or sexual orientation but who are now on institutional tracks to success, Frazier's analysis is inherently dissonant. To accept Frazier is to acknowledge that one's own ascent is intimately connected to acquiescence to the same institutional orders which had barred one's outsider group in the first instance. Though the institution may change to the degree that it accepts the former outsider as neophyte insider, the institutional order maintains the fundaments of inequality that had once allowed the exclusion of the outsider.

From Frazier's perspective, the outsider is never in but is rather a co-opted mimic. Frazier's vision is as sad as it is angry. He believed, in true radical form, that the relatively few African Americans who joined the burgeoning new middle classes of post-World War II America were relinquishing the fleeting opportunity to alter the social landscape and create a more equitable and socially humane world.

In historical sweep and intellectual scope, Frazier's *Black Bourgeoisie* sits on par with C. Wright Mills's *White Collar: The American Middle Classes* (1951). Mills, paradoxically symptomatic of his time, neglected to include any significant analysis of race or gender. In *White Collar* or his other seminal tome *The Power Elite*, His analysis of the political and social tendencies of the white new middle classes, however, concludes with a chapter as telling of its time as it was prophetic of the decades to come, "The Politics of the Rearguard." In that chapter, Mills captures the dynamic that steers the bureaucrats and social aspirants of the new middle classes toward the most convenient and expedient political tendency of the moment. The key quality of the winning trend in the politics of capitalist representative democracies is the absence in that trend of any substantive challenge to the operative economic and cultural order. The white rear guardsmen portrayed by Mills and the black bourgeoisie portrayed by Frazier were both symptoms of
