Reading the Allegorical Intertext Judith H. Anderson, 2010-12-01 Judith H Anderson conceives the intertext as a relation between or among texts that encompasses both Kristevan intertextuality and traditional relationships of influence imitation allusion and citation Like the Internet the intertext is a state or place of potential expressed in ways ranging from deliberate emulation to linguistic free play Relatedly the intertext is also a convenient fiction that enables examination of individual agency and sociocultural determinism Anderson's intertext is allegorical because Spenser's *Faerie Queene* is pivotal to her study and because allegory understood as continued or moving metaphor encapsulates even as it magnifies the process of signification Her title signals the variousness of an intertext extending from Chaucer through Shakespeare to Milton and the breadth of allegory itself Literary allegory in Anderson's view is at once a mimetic form and a psychic one a process thinking that combines mind with matter emblem with narrative abstraction with history Anderson's first section focuses on relations between Chaucer's *Canterbury Tales* and Spenser's *The Faerie Queene* including the role of the narrator the nature of the textual source the dynamics of influence and the bearing of allegorical narrative on lyric vision The second centers on agency and cultural influence in a variety of Spenserian and medieval texts Allegorical form a recurrent concern throughout becomes the pressing issue of section three This section treats plays and poems of Shakespeare and Milton and includes two intertextually relevant essays on Spenser How *Paradise Lost* or Shakespeare's plays participate in allegorical form is controversial Spenser's experiments with allegory revise its form and this intervention is largely what Shakespeare and Milton find in his poetry and develop Anderson's book the result of decades of teaching and writing about allegory especially Spenserian allegory will reorient thinking about fundamental critical issues and the landmark texts in which they play themselves out

Spenser's Afterlife from Shakespeare to Milton Jennifer C. Vaught, 2025-10-01 This study explores how Shakespeare Ben Jonson Andrew Marvell and Milton among many others appropriated Spenser's long and shorter poems for creating comedy parody and satire Their appropriations which were widely influential on communities of readers writers and intertextual networks from 1590 1660 left an abiding impression of Spenser as a biting satirist Spenser's *Afterlife from Shakespeare to Milton* The *Faerie Queene* as Intertextual Environment is the first study to combine the reception history of *The Faerie Queene* with ecocriticism animal studies and posthumanist tenets of vital materialism and the power of things This poem functions as a powerful nonhuman agent that transforms how readers respond to their environments *The Faerie Queene* and its afterlives move readers to perceive flaws in political social and religious figureheads and institutions to envision better ones

Imagining Inheritance from Chaucer to Shakespeare Alex Davis, 2020-02-14 Impossible bequests of the soul an outlawed younger son who rises to become justice of the king's forests the artificially preserved corpse of the heir to an empire a medieval clerk kept awake at night by fears of falling a seventeenth century noblewoman who commissions copies upon copies of her genealogy Elizabethan efforts to eradicate Irish customs of

succession thoughts of the legacy of sin bequeathed to mankind by our first parents Adam and Eve This book explores how inheritance was imagined between the lifetimes of Chaucer and Shakespeare The writing composed during this period was the product of what the historian Georges Duby has called a society of heirs in which inheritance functioned as a key instrument of social reproduction acting to ensure that existing structures of status wealth familial power political influence and gender relations were projected from the present into the future In poetry prose and drama in Chaucer's *Troilus and Criseyde* and his *Canterbury Tales* in Spenser's *Faerie Queene* in plays by Shakespeare such as *Macbeth* *As You Like It* and *The Merchant of Venice* and in a host of other works we encounter a range of texts that attests to the extraordinary imaginative reach of questions of inheritance between the fourteenth and the seventeenth centuries Moving between the late medieval and early modern periods *Imagining Inheritance* examines this body of writing in order to argue that an exploration of the ways in which premodern inheritance was imagined can make legible the deep structures of power that modernity wants to forget

The literary motif of the allegorical knightly quest appears repeatedly in the literature of the late medieval early modern period notably in Spenser but has hitherto been little examined Here in his examination of a number of sixteenth century English allegorical chivalric quest narratives focussing on Spenser's *Faerie Queene* but including important lesser known works such as Stephen Bateman's *Travayled Pylgrime* and William Goodyear's *Voyage of the Wandering Knight* the author argues that the tradition begins with the French writer Guillaume de Deguileville His seminal *Plerinage de la vie humaine* was composed c 1331-1355 it was widely adapted translated rewritten and printed over the next centuries Dr Nievergelt goes on to demonstrate how this essentially medieval literary form could be adapted to articulate reflections on changing patterns of identity society and religion during the early modern period and how it becomes a vehicle of self exploration and self fashioning during a period of profound cultural crisis Dr Marco Nievergelt is Lecturer Maître Assitant and SNF Swiss National Science Foundation Research Fellow in the English Department at the Université de Lausanne

Spenser's Narrative Figuration of Women in The Faerie Queene Judith H Anderson, 2018-03-31 Concentrating on major figures of women in *The Faerie Queene* together with the figures constellated around them Anderson's *Narrative Figuration* explores the contribution of Spenser's epic romance to an appreciation of women's plights and possibilities in the age of Elizabeth

Taken together their stories have a meaningful tale to tell about the function of narrative which proves central to figuration in the still moving metamorphic poem that Spenser created

The Poet and the Antiquaries Megan L. Cook, 2019-04-12

Between 1532 and 1602 the works of Geoffrey Chaucer were published in no less than six folio editions. These were in fact the largest books of poetry produced in sixteenth century England and they significantly shaped the perceptions of Chaucer that would hold sway for centuries to come. But it is the stories behind these editions that are the focus of Megan L. Cook's interest in *The Poet and the Antiquaries*. She explores how antiquarians, historians, lexicographers, religious polemicists, and other readers with a professional but not necessarily literary interest in the English past played an indispensable role in making Chaucer a figure of lasting literary and cultural importance. After establishing the antiquarian involvement in the publication of the folio editions, Cook offers a series of case studies that discuss Chaucer and his works in relation to specific sixteenth century discourses about the past. She turns to early accounts of Chaucer's biography to show how important they were in constructing the poet as a figure whose life and works could be known, understood, and valued by later readers. She considers the claims made about Chaucer's religious views, especially the assertions that he was a proto-Protestant, and the effects they had on shaping his canon. Looking at early modern views on Chaucerian language, she illustrates how complicated the relations between past and present forms of English were thought to be. Finally, she demonstrates the ways in which antiquarian readers applied knowledge from other areas of scholarship to their reading of Middle English texts. Linking Chaucer's exceptional standing in the poetic canon with his role as a symbol of linguistic and national identity, *The Poet and the Antiquaries* demonstrates how and why Chaucer became not only the first English author to become a subject of historical inquiry but also a crucial figure for conceptualizing the medieval in early modern England.

Allegory and Enchantment Jason Crawford, 2017-01-19

What is modernity? Where are modernity's points of origin? Where are its boundaries? And what lies beyond those boundaries? *Allegory and Enchantment* explores these broad questions by considering the work of English writers at the threshold of modernity and by considering in particular the cultural forms these writers want to leave behind. From the fourteenth to the seventeenth centuries, many English writers fashion themselves as engaged in breaking away from an array of old idols: magic, superstition, tradition, the sacramental, the medieval. Many of these writers persistently use metaphors of disenchantment or awakening from a broken spell to describe their self-consciously modern orientation toward a medieval past. And many of them associate that repudiated past with the dynamics and conventions of allegory. In the hands of the major English practitioners of allegorical narrative—William Langland, John Skelton, Edmund Spenser, and John Bunyan—allegory shows signs of strain and disintegration. The work of these writers seems to suggest a story of modern emergence in which medieval allegory, with its search for divine order in the material world, breaks down under the pressure of modern disenchantment. But these four early modern writers also make possible other understandings of modernity. Each of them turns to allegory as a central organizing principle for his most ambitious poetic projects. Each discovers in the

ancient forms of allegory a vital powerful instrument of disenchantment Each of them therefore opens up surprising possibilities that allegory and modernity are inescapably linked that the story of modern emergence is much older than the early modern period and that the things modernity has tried to repudiate the old enchantments are not as alien or as absent as they seem *Architectural Rhetoric in Shakespeare and Spenser* Jennifer C.
