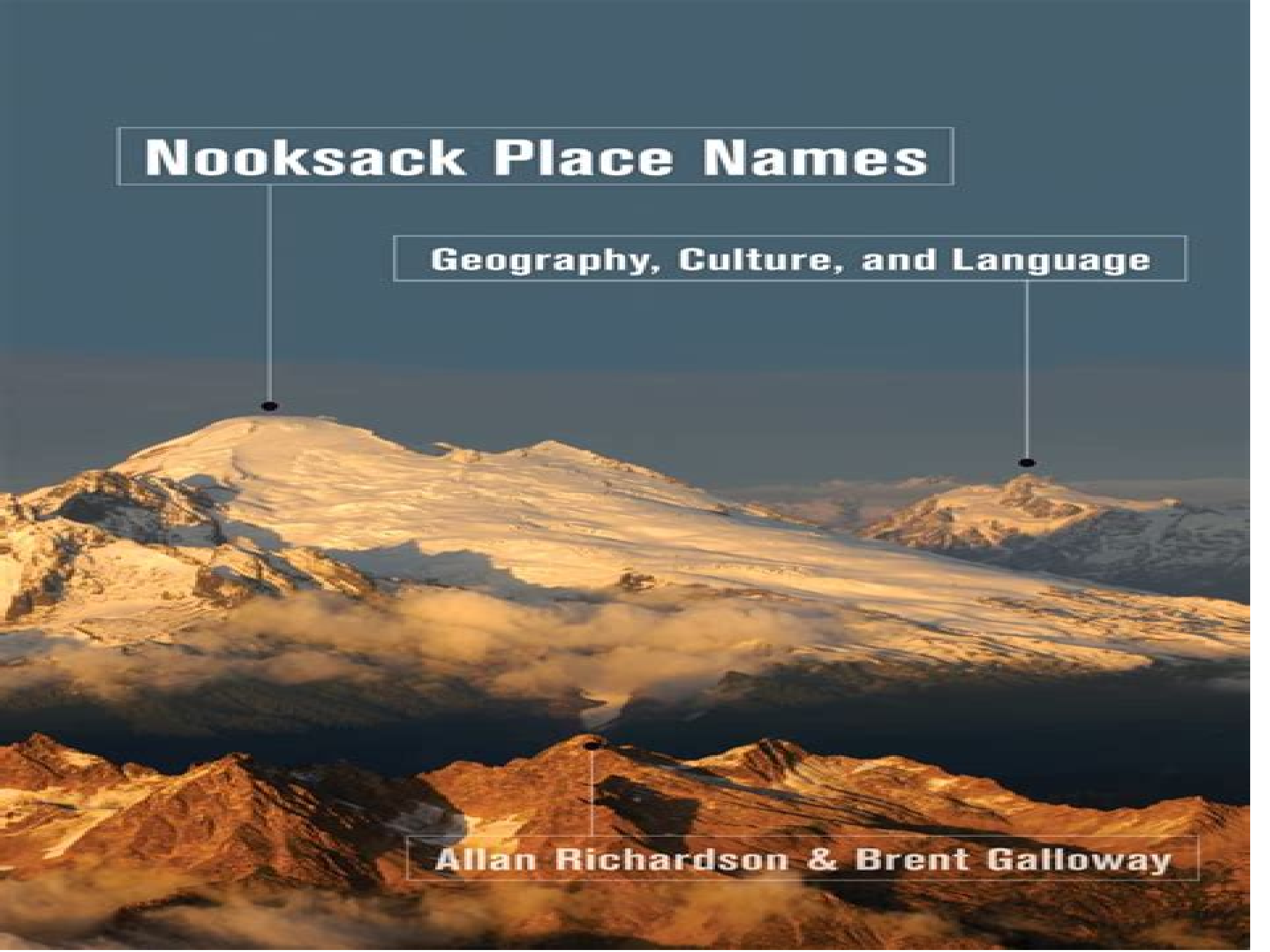

Nooksack Place Names Allan Richardson, Brent Galloway, 2011-08-25 Place names can lead us on fascinating journeys into other cultures They convey a people's relationship to the land their sense of place For indigenous peoples place names can also be central to the revival of endangered languages This book takes readers on an exciting voyage into the history language and culture of the Nooksack Tribe of Washington State and southern British Columbia Allan Richardson and Brent Galloway trace the richness and strength of the Nooksack people's connection to the land by documenting more than 150 places named by elders and mentioned in key historical texts Descriptions of Nooksack history and naming patterns combined with maps photographs and detailed linguistic analyses give life to a nearly extinct language and illuminate the intertwined relationships of place culture language and identity

Peace Weavers Candace Wellman, 2020-10-14

Throughout the mid 1800s outsiders including many Euro Americans arrived in what is now northwest Washington As they interacted with Samish Lummi S Klallam Sto lo and other groups some of the men sought relationships with young local women Hoping to establish mutually beneficial ties Coast and Interior Salish families arranged strategic cross cultural marriages Some pairs became lifelong partners while other unions were short These were crucial alliances that played a critical role in regional settlement and spared Puget Sound's upper corner from the tragic conflicts other regions experienced Accounts of the men who often held public positions army officer Territorial Supreme Court justice school superintendent sheriff exist in a variety of records Some like the nephew of Confederate President Jefferson Davis were from prominent eastern families Yet across the West the contributions of their native wives remain unacknowledged The women's lives were marked by hardships and heartbreaks common for the time but the four profiled Caroline Davis Kavanaugh Mary Fitzhugh Lear Phillips Clara Tennant Selhameten and Nellie Carr Lane exhibited exceptional endurance strength and adaptability Far from helpless victims they influenced their husbands and controlled their homes Remembered as loving mothers and good neighbors they ran farms nursed and supported family served as midwives and operated businesses They visited relatives and attended ancestral gatherings often with their children Each woman's story is uniquely hers but together they and other intermarried women helped found Puget Sound communities and left lasting legacies They were peace weavers Author Candace Wellman hopes to shatter stereotypes surrounding these relationships Numerous collaborators across the United States and Canada descendants local historians academics and more graciously participated in her seventeen year effort

Salish and Abenaki territories through a narrative of Indigenous resurgence In doing so she reveals that the processes philosophies and practices flowing from Indigenous languages and laws can emerge from under the layers of colonial laws policies and languages to become guiding principles in people s contemporary lives **Salish Archipelago** Moshe Rapaport,2024-06-24 The Salish Archipelago includes more than 400 islands in the Salish Sea an amalgamation of Canada s Georgia Strait the United States Puget Sound and the shared Strait of Juan de Fuca The Salish Sea and Islands are named for the Coast Salish Indigenous Peoples whose homelands extend across the region Holiday homes and services have in many places displaced pristine ecosystems Indigenous communities and historic farms Will age old island environments and communities withstand the forces of commodity driven economies This new major scholarly undertaking provides the geographical and historical background for exploring such questions Salish Archipelago features sections on environment history society and management accompanied by numerous maps and other illustrations This diverse collection offers an overview of an embattled but resilient region providing knowledge and perspectives of interest to residents educators and policy makers The Teachings of Mutton Liz Hammond-Kaarremaa,2025-05-20 The pelt of a dog named Mutton languished in a drawer at the Smithsonian for 150 years until it was discovered almost accidentally by an amateur archivist This book tells Mutton s story and explores what it can teach us about Coast Salish Woolly Dogs and their cultural significance Until now there has been very little written about the enigmatic Coast Salish Woolly Dog or sqw mey in the Hul q umi num language According to Indigenous Oral Histories of the Pacific Northwest this small dog was bred for thousands of years for its woolly fibres which were woven into traditional blankets robes and regalia Although the dogs were carefully protected by Coast Salish peoples by the 1900s the Woolly Dog had become so rare it is now considered extinct Co authored with weavers Knowledge Keepers and Elders The Teachings of Mutton interweaves perspectives from Musqueam Squamish St l Suquamish Cowichan Katzie Snuneymuxw and Skokomish cultures with narratives of science post contact history and the lasting and devastating impacts of colonization Binding it all together is Mutton s story a tale of research reawakening and resurgence

Interwoven Lives Candace Wellman,2020-10-14 In this companion work to Peace Weavers her award winning first book on Puget Sound s cross cultural marriages author Candace Wellman depicts the lives of four additional intermarried indigenous women who influenced mid 1800s settlement in the Bellingham Bay area She describes each wife s native culture details ancestral history and traits for both spouses and traces descendants destinies highlighting the families contributions to new communities Jenny Wynn was the daughter of an elite Lummi and his Songhees wife and was a strong voice for justice for her people She and her husband Thomas owned a farm and donated land and a cabin for the second rural school Several descendants became teachers Snoqualmie Elizabeth Patterson daughter of the most powerful native leader in western Washington married a cattleman After her death from tuberculosis kind foster parents raised her daughters who ultimately grew up to enhance Lynden s literary and business growth Resilient and strong Mary Allen was the daughter of an Nlaka

pamux leader on British Columbia s Fraser River The village of Marietta arose from her long marriage Later her sons played important roles in southeast Alaska s early fishing industry The indigenous wife of Fort Bellingham commander George W Pickett later a brigadier general in the Civil War left no name to history after her early death but gifted the West with one of its most important early artists James Tilton Pickett Interwoven Lives was a finalist for the 2020 Willa Literary Award scholarly nonfiction

Rights Remembered Pauline Hillaire, 2016 Rights Remembered is a remarkable historical narrative and autobiography written by esteemed Lummi elder and culture bearer Pauline R Hillaire Sc lla Of the Killer Whale A direct descendant of the immediate postcontact generation of Coast Salish in Washington State Hillaire combines in her narrative life experiences Lummi oral traditions preserved and passed on to her and the written record of relationships between the United States and the indigenous peoples of the Northwest Coast to tell the story of settlers government officials treaties reservations and the colonial relationship between Coast Salish and the white newcomers Hillaire s autobiography although written out of frustration with the status of Native peoples in America is not an expression of anger but rather represents in her own words her hope for greater justice for Indian people in America and for reconciliation between Indian and non Indian Americans based on recognition of the truths of history Addressed to indigenous and non Native peoples alike this is a thoughtful call for understanding and mutual respect between cultures
