while enduring public values associated with morality community and evocations of the past continued to shape Britain's distinctive political culture. This gave a particularly conservative trajectory to the nation's entry into the twentieth century. This study of British political culture from the late eighteenth to the early twentieth century examines the public values that informed perceptions of the constitution, electoral activity, party partisanship and political organization. Its exploration of Victorian views of status, power and authority as revealed in political language, speeches and writing as well as theology, literature and science shows how the development of moral communities rooted in readings of the past enabled politicians to manage far-reaching change.
