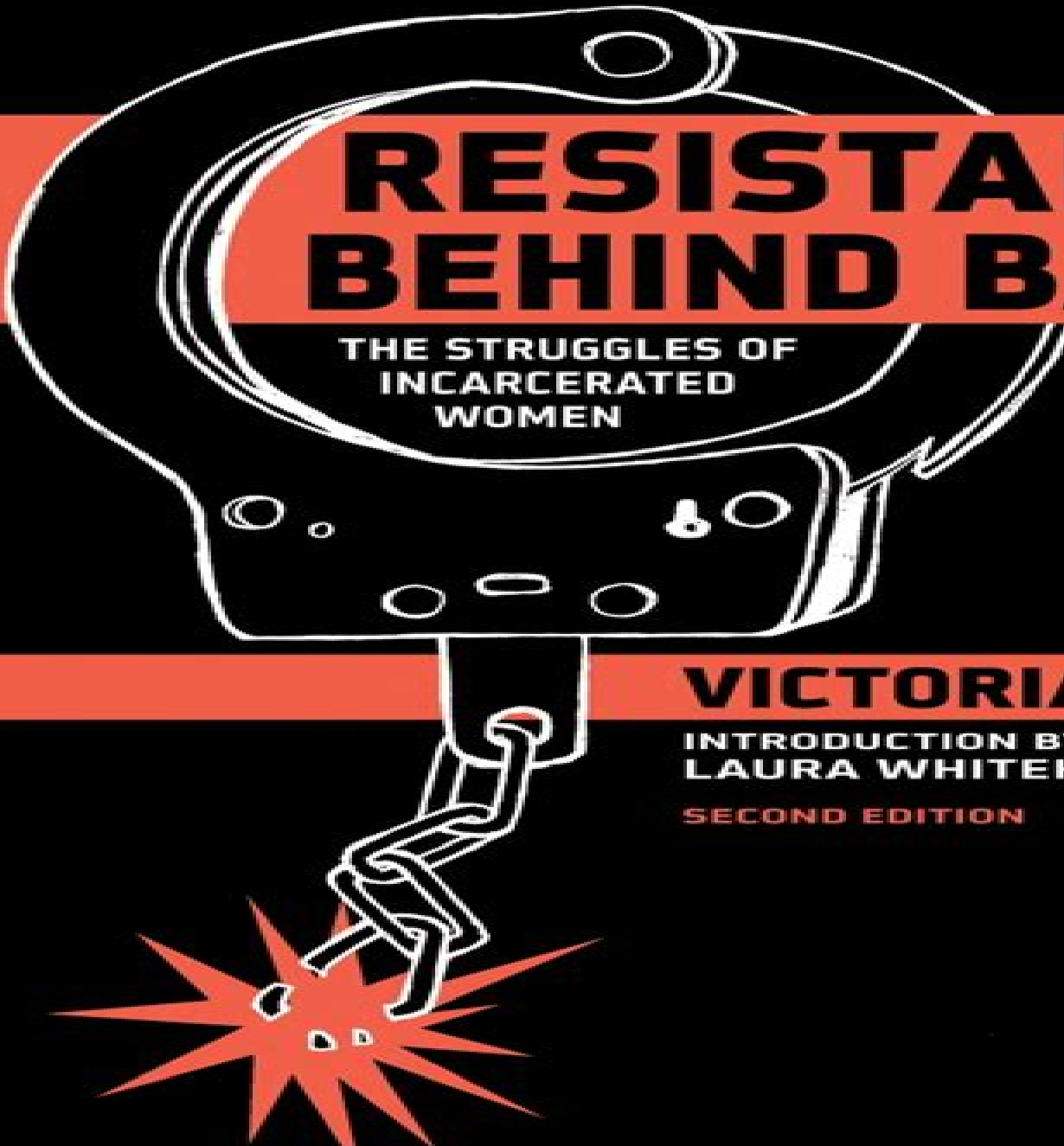

Resistance Behind Bars Victoria Law, 2012-10-05 In 1974 women imprisoned at New York's maximum security prison at Bedford Hills staged what is known as the August Rebellion. Protesting the brutal beating of a fellow prisoner, the women fought off guards, holding seven of them hostage and took over sections of the prison. While many have heard of the 1971 Attica prison uprising, the August Rebellion remains relatively unknown even in activist circles. *Resistance Behind Bars* is determined to challenge and change such oversights. As it examines daily struggles against appalling prison conditions and injustices, *Resistance* documents both collective organizing and individual resistance among women incarcerated in the U.S. Emphasizing women's agency in resisting the conditions of their confinement through forming peer education groups, clandestinely arranging ways for children to visit mothers in distant prisons, and raising public awareness about their lives, *Resistance* seeks to spark further discussion and research into the lives of incarcerated women and galvanize much needed outside support for their struggles. This updated and revised edition of the 2009 PASS Award winning book includes a new chapter about transgender, transsexual, intersex, and gender variant people in prison. Her

starting point was the millions of unwaged women who working in the home and on the land were not seen as workers and their struggles viewed as outside of the class struggle Based on her political training in the Johnson Forest Tendency founded by her late husband C L R James on movement experience South and North and on a respectful study of Marx she redefined the working class to include sectors previously dismissed as marginal For James the class struggle presents itself as the conflict between the reproduction and survival of the human race and the domination of the market with its exploitation wars and ecological devastation She sums up her strategy for change as Invest in Caring not Killing This selection spanning six decades traces the development of this perspective in the course of building an international campaigning network It includes excerpts from the classic *The Power of Women and the Subversion of the Community* which launched the domestic labor debate the exciting *Hookers in the House of the Lord* which describes a church occupation by sex workers an incisive review of the C L R James masterpiece *The Black Jacobins* a reappraisal of the novels of Jean Rhys and of the leadership of Julius Nyerere the groundbreaking *Marx and Feminism* and more The writing is lucid and without jargon The ideas never abstract spring from the experience of organising from trying to make sense of the successes and the setbacks and from the need to find a way forward

Oscar López Rivera Oscar López Rivera, 2013-02-14 The story of Puerto Rican leader Oscar L pez Rivera is one of courage valor and sacrifice A decorated Viet Nam veteran and well respected community activist L pez Rivera now holds the distinction of being one of the longest held political prisoners in the world Behind bars since 1981 L pez Rivera was convicted of the thought crime of seditious conspiracy and never accused of causing anyone harm or of taking a life This book is a unique introduction to his story and struggle based on letters between him and the renowned lawyer sociologist educator and activist Luis Nieves Falc n In photographs reproductions of his paintings and graphic content Oscar s life is made strikingly accessible so all can understand why this man has been deemed dangerous to the U S government His ongoing fight for freedom for his people and for himself his release date is 2027 when he will be 84 years old is detailed in chapters which share the life of a Latino child growing up in the small towns of Puerto Rico and the big cities of the U S It tells of his emergence as a community activist of his life underground and of his years in prison Most importantly it points the way forward With a vivid assessment of the ongoing colonial relationship between the U S and Puerto Rico it provides tools for working for L pez Rivera s release an essential ingredient if U S Latin American relations both domestically and internationally have any chance of improvement

From the Bottom of the Heap Robert Hillary King, 2012-10-05 In 1970 a jury convicted Robert Hillary King of a crime he did not commit and sentenced him to 35 years in prison He became a member of the Black Panther Party while in Angola State Penitentiary successfully organizing prisoners to improve conditions In return prison authorities beat him starved him and gave him life without parole after framing him for a second crime He was thrown into solitary confinement where he remained in a six by nine foot cell for 29 years as one of the Angola 3 In 2001 the state grudgingly acknowledged his innocence and set him free This is his story It begins at the beginning born black born poor born in Louisiana in 1942 King journeyed to Chicago as a hobo at the age of 15 He married and had a child and briefly pursued a semi pro boxing career to help provide for his family Just a teenager when he entered the Louisiana penal system for the first time King tells of his attempts to break out of this system and his persistent pursuit of justice where there is none Yet this remains a story of inspiration and courage and the triumph of the human spirit The conditions in Angola almost defy description yet King never gave up his humanity or the work towards justice for all prisoners that he continues to do today From the Bottom of the Heap so simply and humbly told strips bare the economic and social injustices inherent in our society while continuing to be a powerful literary testimony to our own strength and capacity to overcome The paperback edition includes additional writings from Robert King and an update on the case of the Angola 3

disable to incarcerate multiply marginalized disabled people especially those who are queer trans Black or Indigenous Because disabled people are much more likely than nondisabled people to be locked up in prisons jails and other sites of incarceration abolitionists and others critical of carceral systems must incorporate a disability justice perspective into our work A People s Guide to Abolition and Disability Justice gives personal and policy examples of how and why disabled people are disproportionately caught up in the carceral net and how we can use this information to work toward prison and police abolition more effectively This book includes practical tools and strategies that will be useful for anyone who cares about disability justice or abolition and explains why we can t have one without the other **This Is How We Survive** Mai'a Williams,2019-01-01 In This Is How We Survive Revolutionary Mothering War and Exile in the 21st Century Mai a Williams shares her experiences working in conflict zones and with liberatory resistance communities as a journalist human rights worker and midwife in Palestine Egypt Chiapas Berlin and the U S while mothering her young daughter Aza She first went to Palestine in 2003 during the Second Intifada to support Palestinians resisting the Israeli occupation In 2006 she became pregnant in Bethlehem West Bank By the time her daughter was three years old they had already celebrated with Zapatista women in southern Mexico and survived Israeli detention and during the 2011 Arab Spring they were in the streets of Cairo protesting the Mubarak dictatorship She watched the Egyptian revolution fall apart and escaped the violence like many of her Arab comrades by moving to Europe Three years later she and Aza were camping at Standing Rock in protest of the Dakota Access Pipeline and co creating revolutionary mothering communities once again This is a story about mothers who are doing the work of deep social transformation by creating the networks of care that sustain movements and revolutions By centering mothers in our organizing work we center those who have the skills and the experience of creating and sustaining life on this planet This Is How We Survive illuminates how mothering is a practice essential to the work of revolution It explores the heartbreak of revolutionary movements falling apart and revolutionaries scattering across the globe into exile And most importantly how mamas create no matter the conditions the resilience to continue doing revolutionary work
