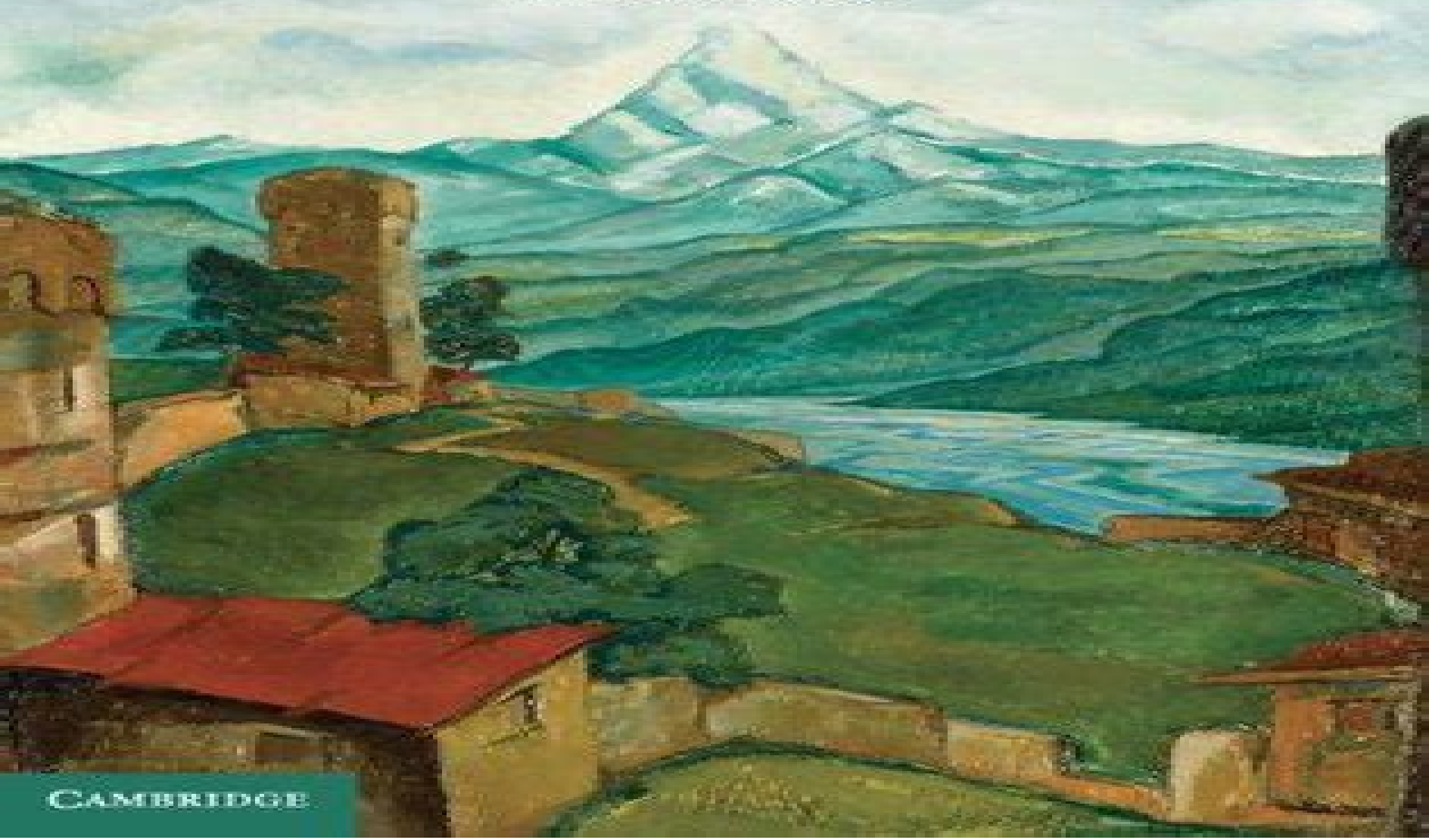


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THE Caucasus

Racheotes, 2018-10-25 The Life and Thought of Filaret Drozdov

1782 1867 *The Thorny Path to Sainthood* is an intellectual biography of the foremost historical figure in the religious world of nineteenth century Russia The product of decades of archival research most of which was in the Russian language this is the first book length study of St Filaret in English The volume is designed for specialists engaged in imperial Russian history students in upper level undergraduate or graduate courses and for readers interested in Eastern Orthodox spirituality and observers of the contemporary Russian scene who wish to understand traditional church state relations Deeply researched and including a formidable bibliographic component the volume also serves as a reference guide to scholars desiring to study at greater length one of the many topics raised Racheotes argues that Filaret was far more than a neo patristic theologian steeped in the tradition of the Eastern fathers He was simultaneously a valued monarchical apologist and a guardian of the privileges of the Russian Orthodox Church to the point of subtly resisting the state By means of translation select passages from sermons letters and official reports are available in English for the first time Often preaching before three reigning tsars writing or editing such monumental documents as Alexander I s will and Alexander II s decree emancipating the Russian serfs leading the drive for a Russian translation of the Bible and preparing Orthodox catechisms are but a few examples of St Filaret s historical importance His centrality to policy formation with respect to the so called Old Believers his incessant campaigns for clerical education reform and for translation into Russian of the seminal works of Eastern theologians account for the enduring influence attributable to this Archbishop Today his pronouncements are enjoying a revival among a new generation of religious historians in Russia and are often adduced by a host of contemporaries arguing for Russian exceptionalism

Resettling the Borderlands Farid Shafiyev, 2018-03-21 Until the arrival of the Russian Empire in the early nineteenth century the South Caucasus was traditionally contested by two Muslim empires the Ottomans and the Persians Over the following two centuries Orthodox Christian Russia and later the officially atheist Soviet Union expanded into the densely populated Muslim towns and villages and began a long process of resettlement deportation and interventionist population management in an attempt to incorporate the region into its own lands and culture Exploring the policies and implementations of the Russian Empire and the Soviet Union *Resettling the Borderlands* investigates the nexus between imperial practices foreign policy religion and ethnic conflicts Taking a comparative approach Farid Shafiyev looks at the most active phases of resettlement when the state imported and relocated waves of German Russian sectarian and Armenian settlers into the South Caucasus and deported thousands of others He also offers insights on the complexities of empire building and managing space and people in the Muslim borderlands to reveal the impact of demographic changes on the Armenian Azerbaijani conflict Combining in depth and original analysis of archival material with a clear and accessible narrative *Resettling the Borderlands* provides a new interpretation of the colonial policies ideologies and strategic visions in the Russian Empire and the Soviet Union

were those anxieties felt more than among the Cossacks The steppe horsemen had famously guarded the empire s frontiers stampeded demonstrators in its cities suppressed peasant revolts in the countryside and served as bodyguards to its rulers Their way of life intricately bound to the old order seemed imperiled by the revolution and especially by the Bolshevik seizure of power Many Cossacks took up arms against the Soviet regime providing the anticommunist cause with some of its best warriors as well as its most notorious bandits This book chronicles their decades long campaign against the Bolsheviks from the tumultuous days of the Russian Civil War through the doldrums of foreign exile and finally to their fateful collaboration with the Third Reich

Mr Five Per Cent Jonathan Conlin, 2019-01-10 Winner of the BAC Wadsworth Prize for Business History 2020 When Calouste Gulbenkian died in 1955 at the age of 86 he was the richest man in the world known as Mr Five Per Cent for his personal share of Middle East oil The son of a wealthy Armenian merchant in Istanbul for half a century he brokered top level oil deals concealing his mysterious web of business interests and contacts within a labyrinth of Asian and European cartels and convincing governments and oil barons alike of his impartiality as an honest broker Today his name is known principally through the Gulbenkian Foundation in Lisbon to which his spectacular art collection and most of his vast wealth were bequeathed Gulbenkian s private life was as labyrinthine as his business dealings He insisted on the highest moral values yet ruthlessly used his wife s charm as a hostess to further his career and demanded complete obedience from his family whom he monitored obsessively As a young man he lived a champagne lifestyle escorting actresses and showgirls and in later life on doctor s orders he slept with a succession of discreetly provided young women Meanwhile he built up a superb art collection which included Rembrandts and other treasures sold to him by Stalin from the Hermitage Museum Published to mark the 150th anniversary of his birth *Mr Five Per Cent* reveals Gulbenkian s complex and many sided existence Written with full access to the Gulbenkian Foundation s archives this is the fascinating story of the man who more than anyone else helped shape the modern oil industry

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
